

Rainier Beach: A Beautiful Safe Place for Youth

Summer Quarterly Report 2021-2022

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About This Report

This report describes crime incidents in the ABSPY intervention area over the summer months of June, July, and August 2022. It is divided into 6 sections: one for each hot spot (Rose Street, Rainier & Henderson, Light Rail, Lake Washington, Our Safe Way) and a summary of all hot spots for the quarter. Each section contains the following data:

1. Number of police offenses this summer 2022 compared to the eight previous summers, 2011-2021 (by age group and broad category: person, property, society, or other)
2. Number of selected offenses in summer 2022 compared to the eight previous summers, 2011-2021 (by age group and offenses of interest at the hot spot: aggravated assault, simple assault, and robbery)

Definitions of Frequently Used Terms

- **Offenses:** Offenses are events that have criminal activity involved. Every offense involved in a single crime activity is reported in the data as a single, distinct crime. There may also be incidents involved within offenses; these are non-crime police activities that took place within the event. We prioritize violent offenses in this analysis. See the example below for information about how this affects the numbers.
- **Incident/Offense Example:** A report will contain all of the offenses or incidents that occurred during a single event. For example, during a traffic stop a driver is arrested for DUI and the police impound their vehicle. The DUI is classified as the **offense** because this is the crime that took place during this event. The vehicle impound is classified as an **incident** because this is a police action that took place during the same event, but it is not a crime event.
- **Person Offenses:** Crimes involving a person as a victim, e.g. assault, aggravated assault.
- **Property Offenses:** Crimes involving loss of or damage to someone's property, e.g. robbery, theft, burglary, property damage, arson.
- **Society Offenses:** Crimes that affect public order and quality of life, e.g. disturbances, liquor violations, drugs, threatening behavior, weapons, prostitution.
- **Other Offenses:** Crimes that do not fit into person, property, or disorder categories, such as fraud and trespassing.
- **Youths:** Individuals 25 years old or younger.
- **Adults:** Individuals 26 years old or older.

Caveats

1. Seattle Police Department uses NIBRS data formatting to count and prioritize offenses, with NIBRS grouping categories "Group A" and "Group B" separating the more serious crimes from the less serious crimes respectively.
2. Crime trends can change rapidly from month to month, especially in small areas.
3. Seattle Police Department recently switched to the NIBRS reporting system and is still in the process of compiling their new database. The new data categorize some offenses differently and as such, numbers are subject to change and should not be compared to previous reports

Major Trends

1. Youth involvement in all but property crime has decreased since last summer. Youth involvement in property crime, on the other hand, has slightly increased since last summer.
2. Since last summer, the frequency of property crimes involving adults has substantially decreased for adults.

Hot Spot Specific Trends

Rose Street

1. Youth were only involved in property crimes this summer.
2. Property crimes involving adults increased since last summer.
3. Person and society crimes involving adults increased since last summer.

Rainier and Henderson

1. Youth involvement in all crime has decreased since last summer.
2. Most youth who were involved in crime were involved in property crime.
3. Adult involvement in property crime has substantially decreased since last summer.

Light Rail

1. Neither youth nor adults were involved in any crime this summer.
2. Adult involvement in all crime decreased since last summer.

Lake Washington

1. Adult involvement in all crime has increased since last summer.
2. Youth involvement in all crime has not changed since last summer.

Our Safe Way

1. Youth involvement in property crime has increased since last summer.
2. Adult involvement in person crime has decreased since last summer.

- **Youth:** There were 282 offenses involving youth in all hotspots in June-August 2011-2022.
- **Adults:** There were 751 offenses involving adults in all hotspots in June-August 2011-2022.

Figure 1: Frequency of Offenses Involving Youth

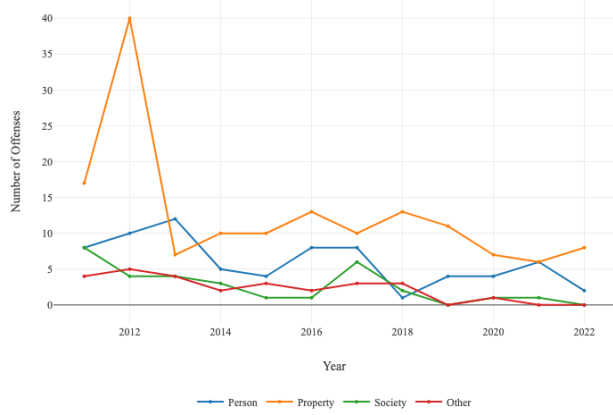
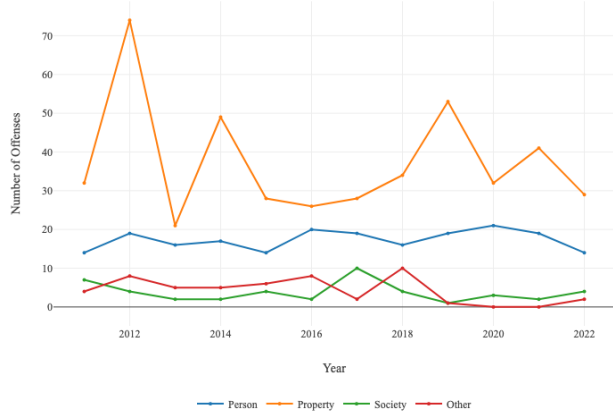

- **Adults:** A total of 189 aggravated assaults, simple assaults, and robberies involving adults in all hotspots in June-August from 2011-2022.

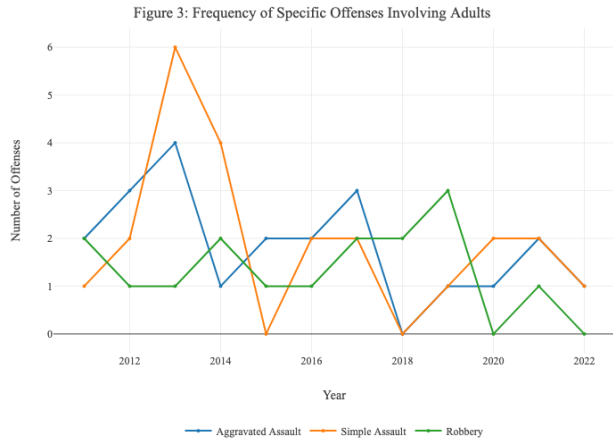
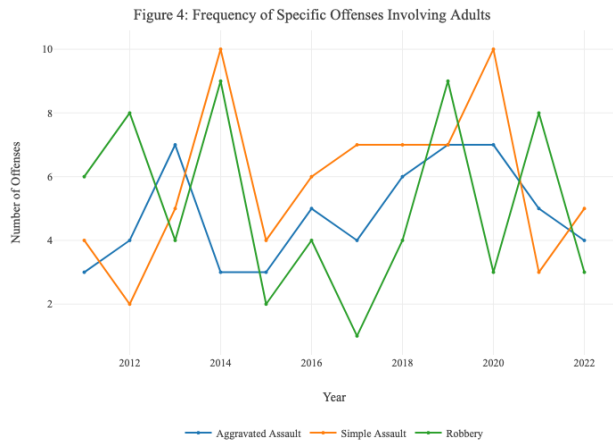

Figure 6: Frequency of Offenses Involving Youth

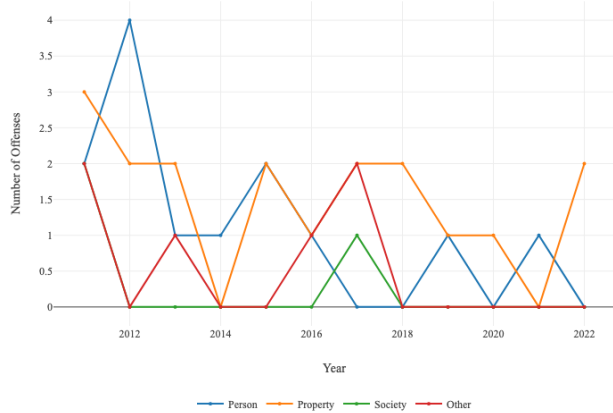
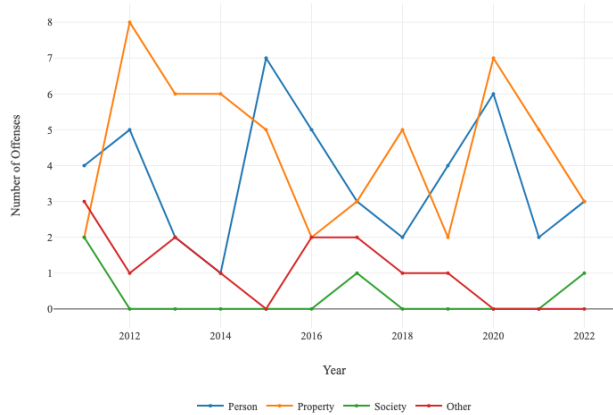

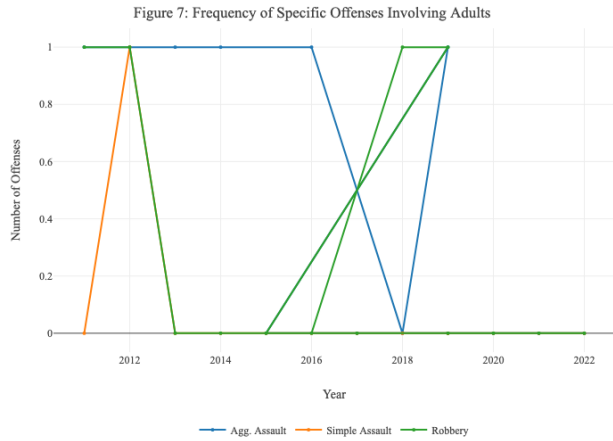

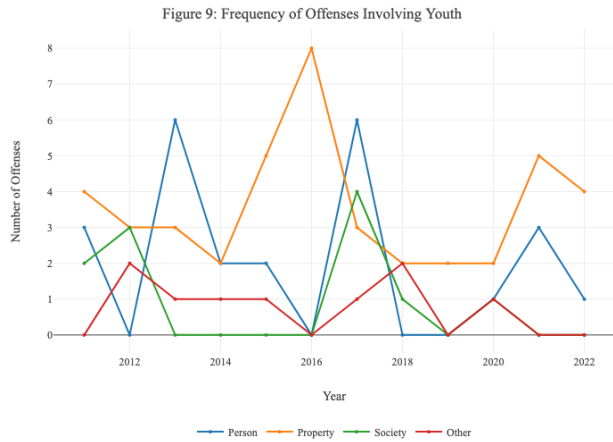
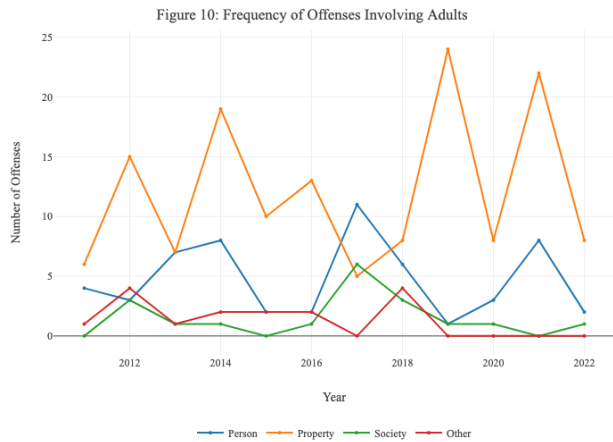

Figure 11: Frequency of Specific Offenses Involving Adults

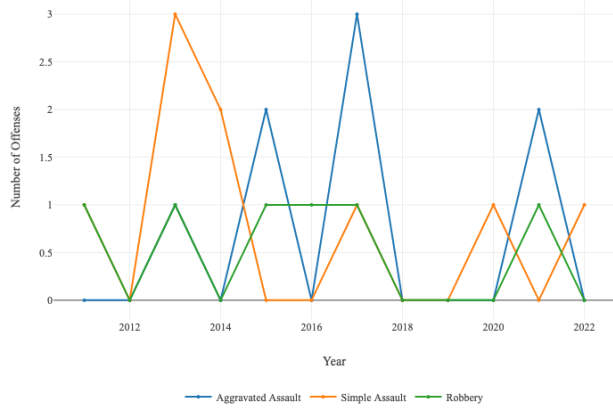
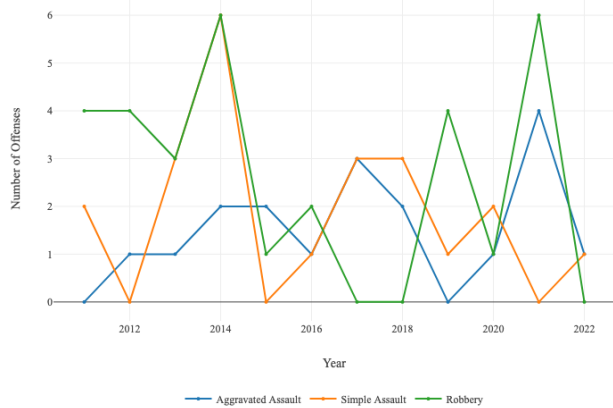

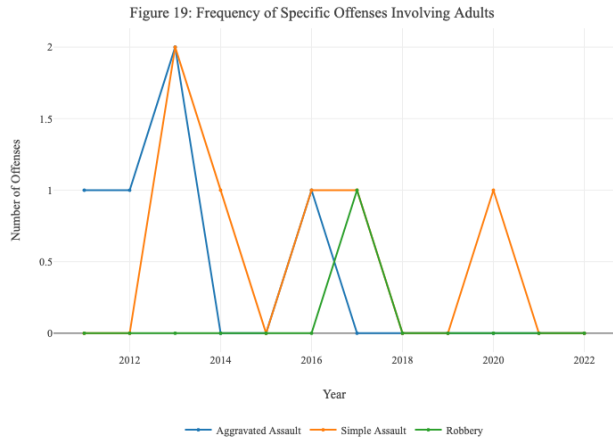

Figure 21: Frequency of Offenses Involving Youth

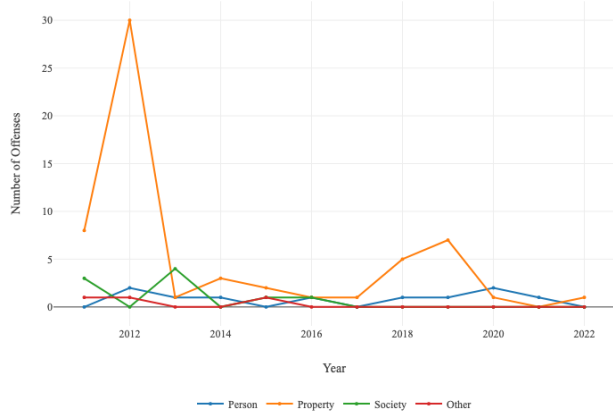
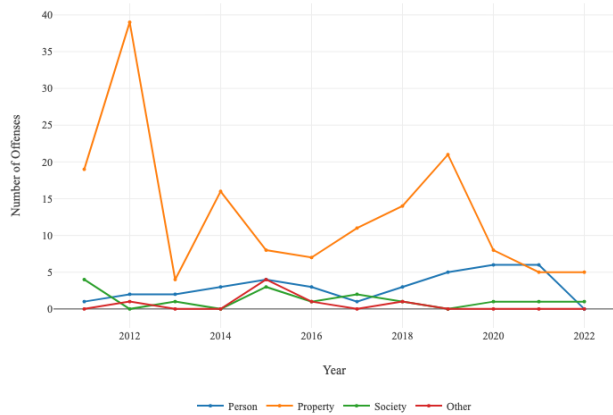

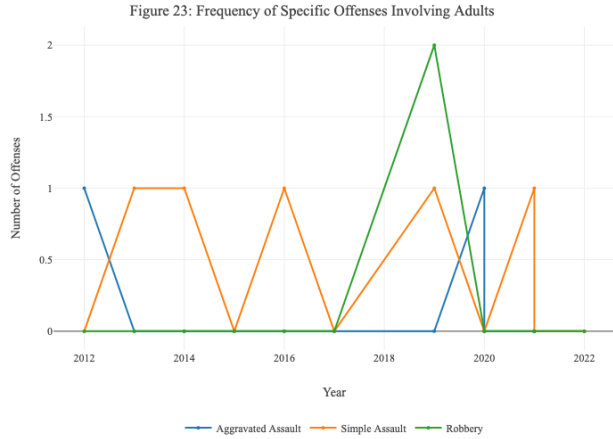
